Rules & Guidelines

I. Camp Rules:

- No shorts or cut offs
- No tank top shirts or muscle shirts
- No jewelry of any kind anywhere on person
- Skirts on girls must be below the knee walking, sitting or standing
- Splits in skirts must be below the knee walking, sitting or standing
- No form fitting or tight fitting clothes
- No low neck, v-neck or revealing shirts
- No make-up
- No hair pieces
- Sleeves must be to elbow. No cap sleeves
- No facial hair or long hair on boys and sideburns no longer than middle of the ear
- No drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, or drug paraphernalia
- No illicit material
- No fireworks
- No slang or curse words
- No fighting
- No inappropriate conversations
- No physical contact between campers
- No Ipods, mp3 players, cd players, etc.
- No campers on Mules, Golf carts, etc.
- Campers who drive their own vehicle must turn in car keys at registration
- Lanyards must be worn during activities & all meals

II. Platform Guidelines for Kids Camp Ages 8-12

- Church style clothes. No play clothes
- No denim
- All camp rules apply

III. Platform Guidelines for Youth Camp Ages 13-21

- Church style clothes (dressy)
- Hose on young ladies
- Ties on young men if possible
- No denim
